### About Oxehealth

We help clinicians, carers and custodians care for society's most vulnerable people. Our platform is used by mental health nurses looking after dementia patients, psychiatrists treating patients in crisis and prison staff caring for ill prisoners.

### Our Product

We offer staff a Digital Care Assistant; an optical sensor pays attention to each patient room and proprietary software algorithms alert staff when they might be needed and allow them to take vital sign measurements. This gives staff more time in which to give hands-on care where & when it's needed most – and better data with which to plan future care. We help staff prevent injuries and improve healthcare. As one medical director remarked, “Your technology will change the practice of medicine.”

### Our Growth

2018 was a stellar year. We obtained our world-first medical device certification, our solution was contracted to >20% of English Mental Health trusts as well as police forces, prisons and care homes - and we launched in Sweden.

We grew our deployments by >10x, were ranked as one of the [UK's 100 fastest growing private companies](#) and were cited by the CQC as an example of [outstanding practice](#).

This is just the beginning. We intend to grow 10x again in 2019. To do that, we need our clinical studies and Development Partnerships to provide us with clinical evidence, insight and data to support our product development and adoption.

## Clinical studies co-ordinator

In this role you will represent Oxehealth in our existing and future Development Partnership collaborations, running these projects alongside senior clinical collaborators. Working with the clinical teams and Oxehealth's researchers, you will develop and write study protocols, participant information sheets and other documents, liaising with Research Ethics Committees, the Health Research Authority and other organisations to obtain the appropriate approvals. You will then help

launch the studies and monitor their progress. On occasions you will visit the wards to help ensure the smooth running of the studies, and will hold regular meetings with the site teams to monitor progress. You may also shadow staff or conduct surveys to understand more about the role of our technology and future product development. You will curate the data sets collected during studies so that they are easy to use for research purposes.

Specific responsibilities include:

- **Running clinical partnership projects** in acute hospitals, mental health settings and care homes. This will involve working closely with clinical collaborators through weekly catch-up phone calls or site visits, and drawing on others in the Oxehealth team to resolve any technical or logistical issues.
- **Designing, writing and running research studies** in external and internal settings, obtaining the appropriate regulatory approvals and supporting day-to-day study activities.
- **Monitor study progress** to ensure that the clinical teams have everything they need for success.
- **Visit clinical environments** to support studies, shadow staff and collect insights to guide the projects.
- **Curate study data sets** so that they can be used for research.
- **Write up findings** as internal reports and published papers
